Dear friend,

Every year, thousands of migrant workers converge in farming camps in Culiacan, Sinaloa, Mexico, for the agricultural harvest. The workers come from all over Central America and represent more than 120 ethnic groups from four countries.

For nearly 30 years, volunteers from American and Mexican churches have joined together with Global Recordings Network (GRN) Mexico for The Culiacan Project — our dynamic outreach conducted annually during harvest times.

GRN missionaries and church volunteers go from camp to camp daily requesting an opportunity to meet with the workers, seeking to identify their precise dialects, distribute audio and visual resources wherever possible, and present an evening program. Not every camp foreman allows our workers access, but for those that do, the results are astounding.

In February, several thousand recordings will be given out in hundreds of languages, resulting in several thousand decisions for Christ registered annually in these camps.

■ Week One: February 1 – 7

Every year the need grows for volunteers and short-term missionaries who are interested in participating in The Culiacan Project. There is a particular need for individuals who can speak Spanish and are comfortable driving in Mexico. We pray that the Lord of the harvest will bring those to grow our outreach network this year.

■ Week Two: February 8 – 14

As the advance team prepares the 60–80 volunteers, pray we have all the necessary digital media to accommodate everyone who hungers for the Word.

With so many migrants arriving from all over Mexico, ask the Lord to aid us in the challenge of quickly distributing digital media in more than 120 languages.

We also ask that each team of 12-15 people who visit the camps will have the necessary digital means to spread the gospel in the language of the day laborers.

■ Week Three: February 15 – 21

We pray that God will open doors as the teams go throughout the camps identifying all the dialects spoken by the migrants and matching them with GRN resources.

Almost every evening, workers are invited to camp meetings where they hear the story of Jesus in their language and can talk with the missionaries and ministries that unite us during this important harvest time. Lord, we pray and thank you for allowing those you call to hear the sound of your voice through these meetings.

As the workers hear and embrace the good news of Jesus Christ, we know that many use social networks to be in contact with their families and friends. Join with us in prayer that they will also distribute GRN recordings socially, as well.

■ Week Four: February 22 – 28

As the missionaries and volunteers return home, and the migrant workers move on to the next season, we thank God for those whose lives have been changed for eternity and for all those who have prayed with us and for us throughout this month.

Throughout the years, the Culiacan Project has successfully planted churches to carry on the work of ministry to those transformed by God's word during this time. Ask the Lord for his abundant blessing on establishing more places of fellowship for these new believers to worship and grow in relationship with Christ.
