1 Praise: Thank the Lord for new volunteers who are joining our Temecula team. Pray for Loy and John as they learn and apply their skills to tasks at hand.

2 Rulisons' Prayer: May the Lord grant wisdom and quick learning for both Dan and Joan as they tackle various challenges in their new jobs.

3 2019 International Year of Indigenous Languages: Pray that GRN can record this year in more languages and places where people still need to hear about God's wonderful gift.

4 Pray for Allan Starling as he researches thousands of names of possible dialects that may need to have their own GRN recording of the gospel message.

5 Local support for GRN Centers: There is a need for our centers and bases around the world to receive more local support for the GRN ministry. Pray that as the church in developing nations grows stronger, it will step up and support local ministries.

6 Brazil training: Pray for the trainees who completed the recordist training course last month – Gustavo and Innes from Equador and Thiago, Fernanda, Dionara, Karine, and Rosângela, that they will have many opportunities to practice what they have learned.

7 Scriptwriters: The content of our messages is vitally important. Ask God to provide GRN with scriptwriters who have insight into the needs of the target audiences. Ask the Lord to anoint the content of each script as it proclaims truth.

8 The Machinga of Tanzania: GRN Tanzania wants many of the 99,000 Machinga people to receive the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and hear about salvation in Christ. Ask the Lord to supply for the cost of a recording project.

9 Ross and Jan Lange: Pray for Ross and Jan who are facing multiple health challenges at this time. May God grant them peace and perseverance.

10 Willing workers needed: GRN USA is praying for the Lord to call 80 new field recordists to join the team and take up our challenge to finish the push to tell the story of Jesus in every language.

11 French-speaking recordists: There is a growing need to have several French-speaking recordists active in Francophone Africa to advance the recording work there. Pray that the recruiting and training of several such recordists will happen in God's time.



12 Europe director still needed: The GRN Europe team is still looking to the Lord for a leader to fill the role of Europe director. Pray for someone with a good grasp of the GRN ethos and mandate and also one with a big heart for God.

13 Praying Scripture: *"Ask of me, and I will give you the nations for your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for your possession.*' Psalm 2:8

14 Colin and Patti Stott: Pray for Colin who serves as the International Prayer Coordinator. Colin and Patti have served with GRN for many years in various capacities. May the Lord grant them joy and peace each day.

15 USA Board: Pray for God's direction for our Board of Directors as they meet today. Pray for healing for Board member Jerome Hannaman who has melanoma.

16 International Leadership Team (ILT): Pray for these members: Graydon, (ID), Christine (Australia), Philippe (Switz.), Larry (USA), John (Togo), and Surendra (Asia). All need wisdom, faith, vision, discernment, and unity of the Spirit to keep them pulling in the same direction,

17 The Dahalo people of Kenya: Our GRN recording team in Kenya is likely to encounter opposition from Muslims when making gospel recordings for the Dahalo people who are followers of Islam. Pray the recording team will not only face and overcome all challenges, but also find willing speakers for the recordings.

18 No known Bauchi:Wayam believers: These people of Nigeria are considered a priority for the GRN team because there are no known believers there. The areas where they live involve dangerous travel. Pray for open doors, resources for recording, and for safety.

19 Many islands and languages: A large number of languages in Indonesia are without a witness of the good news. Pray for GRN recordists as they seek to record Bible stories for people living on the many islands of this Muslimmajority country.

20 Resources needed for Africa: Pray for resources to be available for the ministry of GRN centers so that the team members can fulfill their desire to see God's kingdom advance in all GRN operations in Africa.

21 Health checks and the gospel: Pray for open doors for GRN Thai staff members who regularly visit villages, offering simple health checks as well as sharing the

recorded messages. Pray this approach will help team members to build relationships with the people as well as encouraging local Christians in their faith.

22 The Dabarre people of Somalia: The Dabarre people of Somalia number about 41,000. Their allegiance is to Islam. GRN is committed to provide recordings of the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ to show them that their righteous acts will never attain God's favor. Pray this truth will get to them soon.

23 Roland and Irene King: Pray for them as they work each day in Shipping and with Admin. May they serve with joy in the Lord's strength.

24 Please pray for all the GRN staff and volunteers to be filled with the knowledge of God's will, to live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way, bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, and strengthened with his power unto all patience and long-suffering with joy. 25 Relocation in Kenya: The GRN office in Nairobi needs to relocate. Pray for God's provision for a new space.
