# The served become the servants.

My brother Jon and I heard God's call to record gospel messages many years ago because a Global Recordings Network (GRN) missionary visited a needy Asian country. The local pastors, upon hearing about GRN's ministry in many languages, asked him to send recordists. They saw this as an opportunity to reach the many tribal groups in their country.

In answer to this need and God's call, Jon and I were trained as recordists by GRN and went to serve. We lived with one of the local Christian families as we researched the people groups and their languages.

Right from the beginning we knew this was not something we as foreigners could do on our own. We had to learn a new language just to buy vegetables in the market!

We began asking God to bring young Christian men to join us. God heard our prayers. He brought men to travel with us as translators and guides into the many villages.

On one recording trip my national coworker, Joshua, and I traveled by bus for two days and hiked for three before reaching a people group that lived in remote mountains.

With the help of a tea shop owner and a village school headmaster we were able to play recorded messages in a different local dialect and God opened the hearts of these men to work with us. We spent days recording many messages in their heart language. I did the sound recording while Joshua worked with the speakers to facilitate an accurate translation

We saw the attitudes of these men change from mild interest to conviction

as they spoke God's messages. After returning to the city we prepared the recordings and sent them back with an evangelism team doing outreach in those villages.

As Joshua and others participated in this work, they saw the value of the recordings and the power of people hearing the gospel in their own language.

God continued to raise up young men skilled in Bible knowledge, mechanical and technical skills, and administration – already conversant in the national language, familiar with the cultures around them, and accustomed to multilingual challenges.

One by one they received more training in Bible, linguistics, and recording methods. As they matured, God used these men to expand the ministry of Global Recordings Network to four other Asian countries.

I prayed for this tribe in the remote mountains for years. A few years ago, I was visiting a new GRN center in one of those countries. I was so gratified to find out one new GRN missionary was from that very group for whom Joshua and I had made recordings so many years ago. God brought the spread of the gospel full circle - the mission field has become the missionaries.
