1 At the sound of praise: Praise is a mighty weapon of our warfare. God inhabits the praises of His people. This means that at the sound of praise, the enemy has to flee. He cannot occupy what God inhabits. Praise also demoralizes our ancient foe. So, let us praise and honor the exalted and eternal Son of God, who is the radiance of the Father's glory.

2 Central Asia Camp: Pray for a GRN center that just held their first mission camp. Sixteen participants were encouraged by a speaker who served the tribes for 30 years as a missionary in the south of the country. Pray that God will use all that was shared and studied for His glory and for the furtherance of His kingdom.

3 China challenge: There are hundreds of languages in China without GRN recordings or any other evangelism resource. GRN currently has no recording team assigned to China. Pray for numerous recording teams, perhaps some from the people group with whom we have had contact over the years. Pray for intercessors to help prepare the way.

4 July the Fourth: Pray for our country and its leaders that the freedom of religion in America will be preserved and honored. Pray that many will find true freedom in Christ Jesus.

5 GRN in Germany: Pray for Alfred and Inna as they lead the work in Germany. Pray they will have many open doors and opportunities to share about the work of GRN with churches and missions, and especially with those who work with migrants and refugees.

6 Cameroun challenge: Cameroun has 310 unrecorded languages that we believe would benefit from having access to GRN recordings. Praise God for Joseph and his team and the work they are doing there.

7 New recruits for Cameroun: Pray for new recruits in Cameroun so they can send out more recording teams to tell the story of Jesus. Pray also for intercessors to bring down enemy strongholds in the heavenly realm so workers on the ground can move unhindered.

8 Successful partnership: A partnership resulted in the making of GRN recordings recently in the Philippines. Praise God there was no lockdown at the time. The recordings were well understood and had great impact among those who heard the messages, particularly the Agta: Pudtol, Agta: Pamplona, and Northern Cagayanos.

9 Funds needed for four languages: GRN Kenya hopes to record and distribute four languages spoken in the Karamojong region of Uganda. They are Ik, Pokor West, Akrimojong, and Thur. GRN Kenya also worked on the *Look, Listen and Live* messages for the Akrimojong and Thur in June. Pray for resources to accomplish goals.

10 French-speaking recordists needed: Ask God to provide French-speaking recording team members and bilingual trainers. This will help GRN to boost its recording capacity in many Francophone nations.

11 Christ in us: Pray the Life of Christ will be seen in each GRN worker. The more we die to self, the more His beauty and life will be seen in us. Pray that sin will not have dominion over us. Instead may we long for God's holiness and purity.

12 Mexico recording push: GRN recording teams are systematically traveling throughout southern Mexico. Their quest is to produce the Gospel story for speakers in every unrecorded language group in Mexico. Pray that the Lord will renew the strength of each team and grant them success.

13 Victory in Mexico: Close to 40 groups now have the Good News that was previously unavailable to them in their languages since this big push began in June 2021. Pray for individuals in these groups to respond in faith to the messages.

14 Strong families: Pray for strong marriages and families in GRN, that each worker will strike a good balance between family matters and his or her GRN assignment, as well as having personal time with God each day. Singles too need to balance their time and deal with family issues and relationships.

15 Highest number of unrecorded languages: Papua New Guinea (PNG) has the highest number of unrecorded languages of any country. Praise God for the faithful promotional work being done by Merolyn and Patricia that, together, provides a firm foundation upon which God will advance this work.

16 Breaking barriers in PNG: GRN has no recording teams assigned to this country! Pray for intercessors who will prepare the ground for a spiritual harvest and for numerous recording teams to be recruited to continue building on the amazing work done by those who have gone before.

17 Indonesia needs recruits: ... lots of them! Indonesia is second only to PNG in the total number of unrecorded languages. Over 700 languages are in this category. Pray for many recruits to reinforce the work being done by Ronnie and Chandra. Pray for intercessors to help prepare the way for a fruitful recording ministry.

18 Language investigators: Nigeria is third in the unrecorded language listing with over 400 identified and verified. The small recording team is productive and has been boosted by the recruitment of four language investigators, who will do a lot of the research work that will help recording teams immensely.

19 Prayers for safety: Pray for the Nigeria team that is facing a growing threat from Islamic militants, Boko Haram. Pray for Larry and Nathaniel who are in Nigeria this month training the investigators and searching out recording opportunities.

20 Mexico short term report: "[I went] with GRN on a trip to Sonora, Mex: We visited four agricultural labor camps. As I was hoping to encourage our loved ones there, one couple came forward, actually gave some funds, unsolicited, and shook our hands saying, 'Keep on with Jesus!' So they ministered to me! Our motley crew had ex-cons and power grid engineers but with Jesus in common. . . the Lord was our peace. I guess we will only know what value it really was in heaven. Thank you everyone who permitted me to go." --MEY

21 Preparing for October: Pray for the team planning events in October. There will be International Leadership Team (ILT) meetings and a USA Board meeting at the office in Arizona, with the possibility of an open house for the public. Pray for wisdom in planning, and for the many details involved, that God would be honored in all.

22 Open House: The GRN USA office would like to host an open house this fall. Pray as the date is determined and the notifications go out that many will plan to attend and be encouraged to partner with us in telling the story of Jesus in every language.

23 International Leadership Team: Please continue to pray for God's choice for International Director to be made clear. Graydon, the current director will step down next year. Pray for wisdom for the international council leaders who will be voting on the proposed new ID after he completes the extensive application process.

24 Facebook: Pray for Roland as he posts GRN messages on social media. May the Lord use this outlet to spread His message to many language groups who might be seeking to hear something in their heart languages. 25 Arizona housing: Pray for GRN staff who are seeking the Lord's direction for their housing needs. Pray for them as they look for existing homes to buy or property on which to build something new in the near future. May they be led to the best solution for their needs.

26 Mapping: Pray for Allan and his team of researchers who continue to work on various mapping projects. The maps identify language groups and where they are located – valuable help for the field workers and other missions as well.

27 Okiek distribution: GRN Kenya is thanking God for the recent successful Okiek distribution. Pray that many Okiek will become followers of Christ and worshipers of our Heavenly Father.

28 GRN South Africa: GRN Bible-based bridge materials have been delivered to Bible study group leaders in Malawi where lack of access to Bible content is hindering the growth of new Christians due to the high number of non-readers. Pray that these GRN audiovisual teaching aids combined with audio Bibles may bridge this gap and enhance Bible learning significantly.

29 Migrant outreaches: Pray for volunteer teams who are using GRN evangelism and discipleship materials to reach out to migrants and refugees in Italy and Greece. Pray the Gospel story will give them hope that God knows them and sees their plight.

30 Recordists' request: "The native recordist R. and I plan to be recording two projects simultaneously. Please pray for coordination of the language speakers and that the voicing of the Scriptures would make them come alive for listeners."

31 The sound of praise: Every day I will bless You, and I will praise Your name forever and ever. Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable.
