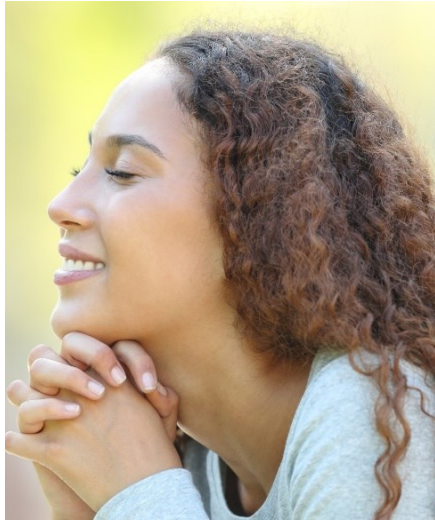


**TOGETHER IN PRAYER**

1. **GRN South Africa:** Give thanks that GRN South Africa is finally fully accredited with their government. They can now legally accept donations. Pray that God leads and guides Dalene and her team to those who would support the work they are doing.
2. **God’s provision:** Pray that we will always look to God our Provider for everything GRN needs to conduct our ministry. Pray that each member of our staff will have sufficient prayer and financial support to enable them to serve with GRN.
3. **Peru Amazon:** Gustavo from Mexico, with Pastor Alejandro and Sister Analia from Iquitos, navigated 17 hours on the Amazon to Santa Rosa. They reached out to different ethnic groups: Ticuna, Maset, Huitotos, Yaguas and others. Welcoming churches gave them radio time for sharing GRN.
4. **GRN Canada:** Pray as Ruth H. works from Canada, continuing to update our database, consisting of thousands of recordings. It is a time-consuming job that takes a great deal of concentration and problem solving. Pray for diligence as she goes through each of the files for the recordings.
5. **GRN Brazil:** Pray for Dionara and our team in Brazil. They are small in number and would love more staff to join the team. Pray for God to call committed and dedicated servants to work for the peoples of Brazil.
6. **Praying Scripture:** *Praise the LORD. Praise God in His sanctuary: praise Him in the firmament of His power.* Psalm 150:1
7. **Tumi Tiger player:** Give thanks for the Tumi Tiger player and its accompanying message, written especially for children dealing with trauma. Pray for all children, including those from Ukraine, who receive a Tiger. Pray that these children will learn that the Lord loves and cares for them.
8. **Pray for Nepal:** Pray for our friends as they tell the story of Jesus in the languages of their country. Pray for our recordist who is suffering from a chronic eye condition.
9. **Pray for Ukraine:** Please continue to pray for peace in Ukraine, and for the thousands of displaced families living in fear and in terrible conditions. Pray for those seeking to bring them hope and a knowledge of God’s peace in the midst of war.
10. **New resource tool:** GRN’s new MapApp is now available. It’s a global interactive map displaying all resources for Gospel sharing in over 6,000 languages of the world. Pray for widespread use of this amazing MapApp.
11. **Accounting Progress:** Our accounting team is very thankful for the assistance of a new accounting company serving non-profits. Pray for Joan, Shannon, and Wayne as they adjust and learn new processes.
12. **Welcome to Ally:** We are thankful that the Lord has led Ally H. to move to Tucson and has called her to work with us in our office. Pray for her as she begins her new life of service to the Lord.
13. **Praying Scripture:** *Praise Him with the sound of the trumpet: praise Him with the psaltery and harp. Praise Him with the timbrel and dance: praise Him with stringed instruments and organs.* Psalm 150:2,3
14. **Pray for Dan R:** Dan is overseeing major projects for the Tucson campus, including a Fire Safety system for our buildings. Pray for wisdom, stamina, and perseverance for Dan and those who work with him.
15. **Central Asian Plans:** Translations in seven languages are ready for recording. Please pray for a breakthrough so these recording needs may be met. We have prayed for these languages for years.

16. **Pray for Diane G:** Diane serves as Global Design Instructional Coordinator, a position for GRN International. She creates online instructional programs for training in various areas of GRN. Using existing or submitted course content, Diane designs curricula to be used in a variety of cultures.
17. **Tool for recordists:** The first version of the *Rekordo* app has now been released. This will facilitate uploading recorded programs and originals directly from the field to the studio in Australia. Pray for effective use of this tool.
18. **News from Mexico:** Missionary Scott writes: *Thank you for these recordings! I have given this link to our Mexican partners in Toluca. I am very hopeful that our people will be able to understand this other dialect of Nahuatl and that we can use it to further the Gospel work in Portrero de San Jose.*
19. **Vision for India:** Many have prayed for the GRN ministry in India for years. At the present time there is no center there, but our heart is to restart this ministry. Pray for God's leading for GRN and for His calling on the lives of those who will serve there.
20. **Praying Scripture:** *Praise Him for His mighty acts: praise Him according to His excellent greatness. Praise Him upon the loud cymbals: praise Him upon the high sounding cymbals.* Psalm 150:4,5
21. **GRN Spain:** Joel and Judith in Spain are thankful for two new team members. Pray for their ministry there. Also pray for Judith who needs surgery to remove a tumor.
22. **From GRN UK:** Director Kenny writes: *Please pray for thousands of refugees coming to UK from Afghanistan, Iraq, and many other countries, risking their own lives travelling in small boats to reach safety. Pray that UK churches and missions will continue to reach out to them with love.*
23. **GRN Netherlands:** Marion and the team in the Netherlands are praying for young people to promote the GRN work among youth. Pray they will find the ideal people for this task.
24. **Canadian Director:** Pray as a search committee evaluates potential applicants for the position of Canadian Director. Pray for God's choice of just the right person to continue the ministry for the coming years.

28. **GRN Thailand:** Pray for the people who are checking the first half of the Thai Good News script. Pray for good follow up with the helpers and that their insights will help to improve the script.
29. **Indonesia:** Pray for more recordists like Josh, who is called to bring the Gospel to several language varieties in Indonesia. May his efforts as one of our partners in the Gospel bring light and life to many now living in darkness and despair.
30. **Pray for opened doors:** Larry continues to make contacts and develop partnerships with Christian workers in Indonesia. His heart is set on making recordings in all the remaining unreached languages of this country.
31. **International Director Graydon:** He asks for prayer for all the preparations and planning that need to be done for the GRN International Council meeting, which will take place in Asia this October. Pray for God's Spirit of wisdom and discernment to fill each center director as they participate.
