- 1 **GRN Philippines:** Pray for Hannah as she works with translators for recording a minority language. Pray for successful translation and adaptation of the selected scripts so listeners get a clear understanding of the Gospel. Pray too for God's provision of language helpers.
- 2 GRN Togo: Emmanuel, son of recordist Bikassam, was in a serious road accident which fractured his arm, displaced his spine, and paralyzed his lower limbs. He has regained some movement but still has far to go. Please pray for Emmanuel and the whole family.
- 3 GRN USA: Pray for Director Bryan and his wife Diane as they take some time away, traveling in England from July 10 to 21. May the Lord bless her elderly parents by this visit, give rest and renewal, and bring them home safely.
- 4 Celebrating freedom: In America today we celebrate the independence of our country, a country blessed with religious freedom. Pray for believers around the world who do not have this freedom but continue to worship Jesus in spite of danger and persecution.
- 5 GRN South Korea: South Korea is one of the missionary-sending countries, but currently GRN needs a new leader. Pray that the Lord will call a person of his choice for this task.
- 6 Praying Scripture: Then they were all amazed and marveled, saying to one another, "Look, are not all these who speak Galileans? And how is it that we hear, each in our own language in which we were born?" Acts 2:7-8
- 7 Future plans: Thank God for the International Leadership Team (ILT), who met in April and May for prayerful planning for the work of GRN across the world. The meetings went well; pray for Tim S and others as they follow up on decisions made.

- Work in India: Please pray for Alisha who is working with GRN. He and his wife are having a difficult time after the church he was pastoring was forced to close by Hindu persecution. Pray also for the editing of the recording in the Chamri language to be finished.
- 9 Cyber security: We have recently been reminded in the news how dangerous the cyber world can be. Pray for protection for all the 1.5 million GRN files in cloud storage, and for the team in Australia actively seeking to keep them safe.
- 10 GRN Spain: The team in Spain is planning distribution in partnership with other organizations and churches in Southern Spain this summer. Pray that the preparations go well and that many will respond to the Good News as a result of the outreach.
- 11 Tumi Tiger ministry: Pray for the traumatized children in Africa and Ukraine who have been comforted by Tumi Tigers. May this be the start of a lifelong relationship with their Savior.
- 12 **GRN Switzerland:** Sam B, the European Director, will be taking the lead role in Switzerland as Philippe has retired. Pray for the work there and that Sam will be able to manage it with his other responsibilities.
- 13 Praying Scripture: "This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear." Acts 2:32-33
- 14 GRN Indonesia: Pray for Ronnie and Chandra in Indonesia as they make new recordings. They recently attended a Leadership Matters Course to develop their leadership skills.

- 15 GRN Thailand: Please pray for the staff there who are facing physical challenges. Pray for complete healing for Lot and Anabel, both of whom have hearing problems, and for Kerry who has been experiencing severe pain in his back and hip.
- 16 Tisdale family: They are currently still in the USA, but plan to return to Thailand, possibly this month. They ask, "We need God's wisdom for Tytus' seventh grade schooling in Chiangmai. The doors we expected to be open have closed, and others are not within our financial means at the moment."
- 17 Thailand staff: Pray for safe travel as Jon and Clair visit friends, family, and churches in the US this month. May their time in the USA bring many blessings, and rest and refreshment, as they share about GRN in many places.
- 18 GRN Mexico: The economic situation where Mexican and Latino missionaries work often leads to financial hardship. Pray for a dependence on God among GRN Mexico workers and for local churches that, upon hearing about GRN, will be moved by God to financially support GRN Mexico workers.
- 19 Mexico recordings: We plan to record two languages, Mixtec:Tidda and Zapotec:Quiavini, an unreached group. Although Tidda had a recording already made, it had to be discarded due to poor testimony. Pray for the helpers and a favorable timing for the recordings.
- 20 Praying Scripture "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" Acts 2:36-37

- 21 Upcoming projects: The Chihuahua Project and Baja Project are distribution trips to agricultural camps in the north of Mexico, to be held in August and October respectively. Pray for the preparations for all workers.
- 22 Nigerian request: From Joshua -- Pray for peace in Nigeria. Many places are no longer safe to even the natives. Many are refugees in their father's land. Pray that God will heal our land."
- 23 Pakistani Sign Language: The recording team is thankful for the opportunity to start the Sign Language translation training this week. The Sign Language team is learning translation principles. Then pray for the team as they spend the next 11 months completing the Good News in Pakistan Sign Language.
- 24 **GRN USA:** Pray for our Board of Directors. Give thanks for Larrie G who has served for a year but is now retired. Pray for the Lord's calling on those who can fill this important position.
- 25 GRN Australia: Information Systems is launching a new project to produce "video shorts." These short video clips will be anything from about 20 seconds to 3 minutes long and will present GRN ministries worldwide. Please pray for this new project.
- 26 Social media evangelism: Pray for our staff who are working on presenting GRN recordings through social media outlets. May God bless these efforts to touch the hearts of people who are drawn to their own home language.
- 27 Praying Scripture: Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them. And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. Acts 2:41-42

- 28 African Recordings: Pray for Yousif who is editing and programming recordings of Look, Listen & Live 1-3 in the Shilluk language, which were recorded in refugee camps in northern Uganda.
- 29 Recordings in Thuri: Praise God for a set of short scripts made in June with Robert, a US citizen born in East Africa. They are in a previously unrecorded language, Thuri. Pray the Lord will mightily use this oral Good News for His glory among the Thuri people.
- 30 Day Alone with God: Pray for the GRN USA staff today as we take a day away from work and distractions to spend time in worship, prayer, and Scripture. May the Lord use this time to renew us, to deepen His work in our hearts, and to inspire us for all that He has ahead for the GRN ministry.
- 31 New workers: Praise God with us as we start to see staff and volunteers join our work here in the US. Pray for Aidan, Rhonda, Robert, and others as they are oriented to our ethos and our work.
